

ADAA - HELP WITH COMPETITION ENTRY FORMS

Refer to Competition Schedules when completing forms for the available events to enter. With the introduction of new Regulations there has come the need for new abbreviations when completing an Entry Form.

See the listing below for the abbreviations and examples.

COMBINED PROGRAM:

CE = COMBINED-ELEMENTARY (for Agility/Jumping Tests only)

CS = COMBINED-STARTERS (for Agility/Jumping Tests only)

COA = COMBINED-OPEN A (for Pairs/Team Games only)

COB = COMBINED-OPEN B (for Pairs/Team Games only)

INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM:

I = INTERMEDIATE

OA = OPEN A

OB = OPEN B

A = ADVANCED

CLASS:

TY = TOY

MN = MINI

MD = MIDI

MX = MAXI

REGULAR PROGRAM:

RI = REGULAR-INTERMEDIATE

ROA = REGULAR-OPEN A

ROB = REGULAR-OPEN B

TEST/GAME:

AT = AGILITY TEST

JT = JUMPING TEST

IG = INDIVIDUAL GAME GAMBLERS

IS = INDIVIDUAL GAME SNOOKER

IO = INDIVIDUAL GAME OTHER

PS = PAIRS GAME STRATEGIC

PO = PAIRS GAME OTHER

TK = TEAM GAME KNOCKOUT

TO = TEAM GAME OTHER

JUNIOR PROGRAM:

JE = JUNIOR-ELEMENTARY

JS = JUNIOR-STARTERS

JI = JUNIOR-INTERMEDIATE

Examples below. These go in the boxes that say Class Name on the Entry Forms (remember to include the Class Number as well on your entry - refer to the Competition Schedule).

EXAMPLES—INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM:

OAMXIG: Open A Maxi Individual Gamblers

ITYJT: Intermediate Toy Jumping Test

AMXJT: Advanced Maxi Jumping Test

OBTYAT: Open B Toy Agility Test

EXAMPLES—JUNIOR PROGRAM

JIMXAT: Junior-Intermediate Maxi Agility Test

JSMNJT: Junior-Starters Mini Jumping Test

EXAMPLES—COMBINED PROGRAM:

CEMXAT: Combined-Elementary Maxi Agility Test

CSMNJT: Combined-Starters Mini Jumping Test

COBMNPO: Combined-Open B Mini Boxed Pairs

COAMXTR: Combined-Open A Maxi Team Relay

EXAMPLES—REGULAR PROGRAM:

RIMDJT: Regular-Intermediate Midi Jumping Test

ROAMXIS: Regular-Open A Maxi Snooker

RITYJT: Regular-Intermediate Toy Jumping Test

ROBMNIO: Regular-Open B Mini Individual Power & Speed
