

Guide for Clubs and Competition Secretaries May 2017 – Edition 10

This guide includes a Sample Schedule based on the 10th Edition of ADAA's Agility Regulations with effect from 1 May 2017, detailing a variety of ways in which Clubs may wish to offer events to enable dogs to be entered. This is a guide to help Clubs formulate schedules for the Regulations. This is by no means a schedule that is recommended, but rather demonstrating how to put together a schedule by offering events to enable Juniors and Regular registered dogs to be offered events.

Additionally, it demonstrates the use of Open A and Open B categories. Within a single competition, the Club may deem all Open events to be Open B or all to be Open A, or have some of each.

Dogs may, at any time, be entered in height classes above their own, but never below. A Dog may only compete once on each course though, i.e. a Midi dog may be entered in a Combined-Starters Maxi Agility Test and on the same day be entered in an Intermediate Midi Agility Test. The new jump/tyre heights of 500 mm and 600 mm must be altered on equipment by May 2017 (or exemption received from ADAA).

With the exception of an approved beginners' competition, all events listed on a schedule must be offered to dogs from the International Programme Register. The Club may choose which events will be offered the extra classes to allow either or both Regular registered dogs and Junior competitors, however it is normal that Regular always be offered, when applicable.

The best way to work out what you want is to work out a basic schedule (which standards and how many course changes that you want) and then add in the extra classes as desired for both Regular and Junior Programmes. Combined-Starters, Combined-Elementary and Combined-Team/Pairs games allow both Regular and International registered dogs, so Regular classes are never required for these events. Open and Advanced events are never offered to Junior competitors.

NFC – Not for Competition. Training in the ring is not allowed however competitors may nominate to run as NFC in Agility and/or Jumping Tests (except for Advanced/Regular-Advanced). NFC competitors are allowed to stay out on course for a time not exceeding the Standard Course Time set by the judge. NFC competitors enter with the same process and pay the same entry fee as all other competitors. They indicate to the Judge (and Stewards) upon entering the ring that they wish to utilise NFC for that round.

(Individual game for both International and Regular register dogs. Open B symbolises that dogs without their AAD title may not compete in these events),

(Only dogs with at least their SAAD or R-SAAD title may compete in this event. NFC would not be allowed in this event).

(Open course including both International and Regular registered dogs. Open A symbolises that dogs without their AAD title may enter these events)

(Intermediate course including International and Regular Register dogs but no Junior competitors)

(Team and Pairs games are offered as part of the Combined programme and dogs registered on both the International and Regular registers are eligible to enter. Open A symbolises that dogs without their AAD title may enter these events. NFC would not be allowed in this event).

10b. Combined-Open A Midi Team Game

10c. Combined-Open A Mini Team Game

10d. Combined-Open A Toy Team Game

Note: Dogs may only be entered in any one Class a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h, I, j, k or l from each event.
